

## Tentative Trailer/Boat Race Rules- Benton County Speedway 2025

### Tow Vehicles:

1. Any cars or pickups are legal. NO Semis. If tow vehicle is deemed inappropriate or unsafe to be on the track, vehicle will not run.
2. No altering of suspensions, must remain stock.
3. All glass must be removed except front windshield is optional.
4. All exterior lights must be removed.
5. All tow vehicles must have working brakes.
6. No dual wheeled vehicles allowed.
7. NO chains on tires, NO solid filled tires. Must be stock DOT tires.
8. NO added weight on tow vehicles.
9. All unsecured items need to be removed from tow vehicle.
10. Driver's door must be chained or welded shut.
11. No passengers and no changing of drivers allowed.
12. Must have number on tow vehicle not less than 24"
13. Roll bars are allowed. Highly recommend driver's door bars-2" flat steel or 2" round or square tubing on the outside of the vehicle and not extending more than 12" past door seams.

### Safety:

1. All people in the pits must sign wavier form and have on wrist band.
2. Full face helmet and long sleeve shirts and pants required. No open toe shoes allowed.
3. Shoulder and Lap belts are required. Racing harness is recommended.
4. Air bags must be removed.
5. NO Alcohol allowed.
6. Must be 16 years of age Under 18 must have Minor Release form filled out.

### Trailers:

1. Tires must be on outside of frame rail. They cannot have any type of protection around them.
2. Trailers to be single or dual axle.
3. Trailers MUST have a boat attached to it.
4. Any loose material inside the boat must be removed.
5. Boats must have motors removed.
6. Trash on trailer not allowed. Objects must be secure to trailer. Objects must be approved by the judges.
7. HITCHES: Ball type only. No goose-necks, or pin type hitches. Tongue of trailers cannot be made to spin around. Safety chains are allowed. Max diameter 5/16" and must be attached to trailer tongue.

### Race Rules:

1. Object of race- FINISH race with your trailer while separating the trailer of your competitors from their tow vehicle. If you lose your trailer during the race you are DQ'd and must move to the infield.

2. If you lose your boat you can continue to race.
3. If your trailer loses its axles you will be DQ'd.
4. No tow vehicle to tow vehicle hits. Vehicle to vehicle hits will be DQ'd.
5. First vehicle to finish race with eligible trailer or last vehicle with eligible trailer attached wins.
6. Trailers will be tech-ed before the start of each race- not attached to the tow vehicle.
7. Feature winner WILL BE TECH-ED.
8. All decisions by officials are final.
